#### Course Description

In this course we will examine a specific topic in phonology. The topic this semester will be Interlanguage Phonology. This class will be aimed at students with some previous knowledge of phonetics/phonology. We will examine three main areas within Interlanguage Phonology: the phonology of pidgins and creoles, loanword phonology and second language phonology in order to better understand the similarities and differences in these areas. This seminar-style course will consist of a combination of lectures and discussion of journal articles led by class members.

#### Course Textbook

There will be no textbook for this course, since there is no book that adequately covers the topics. We will read various articles on topics related to language acquisition, taken from various relevant sources.

#### Course Website

There is a website for this course, which will contain the various articles that we will be examining, as well as other information concerning the class. It is located at the address above.

#### Assessment

This class will be conducted in seminar fashion with one person leading discussion of a paper and the others contributing their views on it. Assessment will be based on attendance and participation, as well as leading the discussion of three journal articles and writing a summary of each paper (1000 words for each summary).

Class attendance and participation: 10%

Leading discussion of three papers: 15% each = 45%

Submission of three summaries: 15% each = 45%
